What do we do?

We are a team of registered nurses/midwives with specialist training in community public health nursing and are closely supported by qualified community health nurses and nursery nurses.

We work with local communities, families and individuals in different settings to deliver the Health Child Programme by offering five universal contacts to all children 0-5 years. We also provide targeted support to vulnerable individuals or families.


We work closely with other health services and local children centres, to ensure the child's health needs are met and that they are living in a safe environment.

The core contacts we provide are:

- Ante-natal contact
- Post-natal contacts / new birth visit
- Maternal mental health contact
- 10-12 month health and development review
- 2 – 2½ year health and development review
- New to area contact
