Who we are


We are one of the largest acute and community providers in the West Midlands having more than 850 beds on the New Cross site.

We also have 56 rehabilitation beds at West Park Hospital and 54 beds at Cannock Chase Hospital.

We are the largest employer in Wolverhampton, the Trust employs more than 8,000 staff, covering more than 350 different roles.

We provide services from the following locations;

- New Cross Hospital – secondary and tertiary services, maternity, Accident and Emergency, critical care and outpatients
- West Park Hospital – rehabilitation inpatient and day care services, therapy services and outpatients
- Cannock Chase Hospital – general surgery, orthopaedics, breast surgery, urology, dermatology and medical day case investigations and treatment (including endoscopy)
- More than 20 community sites – community services for children and adults, walk-in centres and therapy and rehabilitation services
- Primary care – Nine GP practices have now joined us and offer extended opening hours to patients.



Where we are located

New Cross Hospital is located near Wednesfield on the eastern side of Wolverhampton. It is in easy reach of Wolverhampton city centre which is about two miles away.

Cannock Chase Hospital is located in the centre of Cannock. It is approximately 4 miles from Junction 12 of the M6.

West Park is centrally located just outside of Wolverhampton city centre.

Our GPs, community sites and services are located across the Wolverhampton area.


New Cross Hospital

New Cross Hospital was originally built as a workhouse. The first phase of the modern hospital, built by Alfred McAlpine, was completed in 1970. Since then it has grown and become the main acute general hospital for Wolverhampton, replacing The Royal Hospital, on Cleveland Road, which closed in June 1997.

In 2004 the £57m Heart and Lung Centre opened on the site, the UK's first purpose built specialist heart centre.

The hospital provides secondary and tertiary services, maternity, critical care and outpatients.

In 2015 a new £38 million Emergency Department was opened at the hospital. Boasting 30 treatment rooms for minor injuries, 18 for major injuries and a resuscitation area for adults, as well as a dedicated paediatric area for children. The Emergency Department is one of the largest in the region.



Community and GP Practices

The Trust has more than 20 community sites providing community services for children and adults, walk-in centres and therapy and rehabilitation services.

One of these community sites is Wolverhampton's ground-breaking Gem Centre for children and young people. The centre in Wednesfield provides specialist community health services for children and young people.

Leading the way in delivering integrated care between primary and secondary providers, we have nine GP practices.

This is an area which continues to grow. Having GPs as part of the organisation offers a unique opportunity to redesign services from initial patient contact through on-going management and end of life care.




Cannock Hospital

Cannock Chase Hospital is a thriving, busy site offering a wide range of surgical procedures for patients from Cannock, Wolverhampton and surrounding areas. A total of £27 million was invested in new operating theatres and refurbished wards over the last few years. Cannock Chase Hospital is a hub of activity for day cases and inpatient surgery. The hospital provides;

- General surgery (examples include hernia repair and gall bladder surgery)
- Orthopaedics (includes hip, knee, foot, ankle and upper limb surgery)
- Breast surgery (not cosmetic)
- Urology (includes bladder and kidney)
- Dermatology/plastic surgery (removal of lumps and lesions)

Cannock also provide the following day case investigations and treatment;

- Endoscopy (examples include colonoscopy and gastroscopy)
- Rheumatology (includes day care and intravenous treatment for conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis)
- Dermatology (includes phototherapy, intensive topical skin treatments).



West Park Hospital

West Park Hospital is steeped in history and is located in a leafy suburb of Wolverhampton. With West Park on the door step, it is a great location for recreation and to enjoy during a quick break.

The three-ward facility provides rehabilitation services for patients with neurological disorders and those who have suffered strokes.

It also provides day care services, therapy services and outpatient appointments.

Training

As a Trust we are absolutely committed to education and training as this improves the knowledge of our staff and outcomes for our patients. We have a modern, purpose built education and development centre where training sessions are held daily.

There is also a weekly training bulletin sent to all staff with a wide variety of courses advertised including human behaviour management and self-awareness.

The Trust also provides opportunities for development of its workforce through a variety of routes, one of which is Foundation Degrees.

Fellowship Programmes

We run an innovative Clinical Fellowship Programme – which is hugely popular.

The programme is suitable for UK and overseas doctors seeking clinical experience, a high quality training programme, enhanced qualifications and career progression.

We also recently launched a Staff Nurse Clinical Fellowship Programme – helping our nurses develop their career while working within cutting edge clinical practice.

12 Month Nurse Preceptorship Programme

Best Start is The Royal Wolverhampton NHS Trust 12 Month Preceptorship programme.

The programme includes both theoretical and self-directed study and competency assessment within clinical practice, and offers support and guidance during the first 12 months of registration.
