

Job Summary

The post holder will work as a team leader in the Endoscopy decontamination area, ensuring scopes are processed and available for all endoscopy procedures and work as an assistant within the Endoscopy procedure rooms.

The post-holder will demonstrate their own duties to new starters, bank/agency staff and will provide teaching and supervision of more junior staff. They will also provide support for the Registered Nursing staff in maintaining a stable and safe clinical environment. The post-holder will also provide clinical supervision to less experienced staff.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Clinical Responsibilities:

- 1.1 Assist with the recovery of sedated Endoscopy patients ensuring that observations are recorded and nursing staff are alerted of any abnormalities. Assess patient condition through basic observations/assesses comfort of patients.
- 1.2 Work in the decontamination area of the Endoscopy unit. Process endoscopes through the decontamination process and ensure safe storage of the clean scopes. Make sure that scopes are ready for use for each procedure.
- 1.3 Assist within the endoscopy procedure rooms. Record observations, assist with biopsy collection and ensure the comfort and safety of the patient.
- 1.4 Provide and maintain a high standard of total patient care at all times, ensure the dignity and self-esteem of the patient/client is preserved.
- 1.5 Ensure that the regular weekly water testing is completed and the samples are sent promptly to obtain results.
- 1.6 Contribute and participate in the positive working team and the Trust as a whole.
- 1.7 Assist with maintaining the cleanliness of the hospital environment thus, contributing the control of infection.
- 1.8 Ensure that the decontamination area runs smoothly and is correctly staffed reporting to senior nursing staff/leadership team with any deficiencies.
- 1.9 Maintain confidentiality at all times, only provide patient/client information under the guidance and supervision of a Registered Nurse.
- 1.10 Assist in maintaining a safe environment for patients/clients, visitors and other staff, as directed by the nurse in charge.
- 1.11 Undertake other duties, as directed, such as cleaning, storing and checking of equipment and maintaining storage areas in an orderly manner. Maintains decontamination area stock control.

2. Mandatory and Statutory Responsibilities:

- 2.1 Attend mandatory updates as specified by the Trust
- 2.2 Undertake other training and study days as directed by the Senior Sister/Charge Nurse.

3. Educational and Development Responsibilities:

- 3.1 Attend teaching programmes for ward and specialty.
- 3.2 Participate in the annual Knowledge and Skills Framework (KSF) as part of own appraisal and development.
- 3.3 Actively contribute to educational activities within the Endoscopy
