Acute Inpatient	Addiction (Forward Leeds)	Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
For primarily people of working age who have come to us via the Crisis Assessment Services.	Treatment for those with complex needs who misuse alcohol and other drugs.	For adults and young people who need monitoring and management of their condition.
Autism Diagnosis	Blue Light	Care Homes
Serving people living in Leeds of all intellectual abilities who may have autism.	We support our partners in the emergency services in Leeds, including the police and paramedics.	We work with residents with mental health problems in care homes across Leeds.
Children and Young People's Mental Health Services Inpatients	West Yorkshire Children and Young People's Mental Health	Chronic Fatigue Syndrome / Myalgic Encephalomyelitis
The service is staffed by nurses plus psychiatrists, teachers, clinical psychologists, occupational therapists, a dietician, family therapist, and pharmacist.	This is a new inpatient service based in Armley, Leeds, from December 2021 for young people experiencing significant psychiatric, psychological or emotional problems.	A Leeds and West Yorkshire NHS service for people with chronic fatigue syndrome, otherwise known as ME, or myalgic encephalomyelitis.
Community Disability Learning Team	Community Mental Health	CONNECT: Eating Disorders
The Community Disability Learning Team includes psychiatrists, psychologists, physiotherapists and learning disability nurses.	The Leeds Community Mental Health Service provides adult specialist community mental health services.	Early intervention, outpatient, inpatient and intensive home-based treatment for adults with eating disorders such as anorexia nervosa and bulimia nervosa.
Crisis Assessment Unit	Crisis Resolution Intensive Support	Deaf Children and Adolescent Mental Health Service – National
This 24/7 service supports adults experiencing an acute and complex mental health crisis who may require extended assessment and treatment.	Providing intensive support at home to 18-65 year olds in mental health crisis. Operates 24/7 all year.	We work with 0-18 year-olds with a severe to profound hearing loss, deaf parents or British Sign Language as a first language.
Gender Identity	Healthy Living	Intensive Home Treatment for Older People
Assessment and support to those aged 17+ with gender dysphoria.	Focused on our acute inpatient services, this service helps people improve their physical health.	This team assesses and cares for older people with more acute, complex problems related to their mental health or dementia at home.
Learning Disability Inpatient Services	Learning Disability Specialist Health Planned Care (Respite)	Liaison Psychiatry
Offering respite for those with profound and multiple learning disabilities and people with challenging behaviour.	Providing care to adults with challenging behaviour and associated complex health needs.	This team supports people whose physical health problems have led them to experience emotional difficulties.

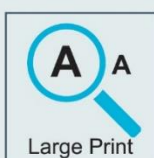
Locked Rehabilitation	Low Secure Forensic Service Leeds	Low Secure Forensic Service York
We work therapeutically with service users to reduce their risks to themselves or others while increasing engagement and independence.	This service provides inpatient, outpatient and community outreach support to the local Leeds population.	We provide an inpatient service to adults in York from a range of pathways.
Memory Assessment	National Inpatient Centre for Psychological Medicine	Northern Gambling Service
This team provides assessment, diagnosis, treatment and support for people with dementia and mild cognitive impairment.	Delivering bio-psychosocial holistic care for people with complex medically unexplained symptoms and physical / psychological co-morbidities.	We provide specialist addiction therapy and recovery to people affected by gambling addiction.
Older People's Inpatient Services	Older People's Community Mental Health	Pathway Development Service – Yorkshire and Humberside
For people with acute mental health needs including dementia, provided 24 hours a day in a hospital setting.	This is a dedicated service for those over 65 and living in Leeds.	Serving people diagnosed with severe personality disorder.
Perinatal Mental Health Service	Personality Disorder Managed Clinical Network (Leeds)	Pharmacy
Our specialist service supports women with significant mental health difficulties during pregnancy and the first year following a child's birth.	This service works with people with personality disorder, complex needs, and significant risk issues. It is multi agency and multi-disciplinary.	The pharmacy team work alongside medical, nursing and other clinical staff to ensure medicines are used safely.
Psychiatric Care Intensive Service	Rehab and Recovery Inpatient	Specialised Supported Living Service
The Leeds Psychiatric Care Intensive Service cares for adults whose risks and behaviours cannot be managed on an open acute ward.	These services offer comprehensive assessment and individual care packages in a safe and supportive environment.	This service helps adults with varying degrees of learning and physical disabilities and complex needs to live independently.
Veterans' Mental Health Complex Treatment Service	Veterans' Mental Health High Intensity Service – North of England	Younger People with Dementia Service
The Veterans' Mental Health Complex Treatment Service is a specialist community service for armed forces veterans.	This team provides care and treatment for armed forces veterans in a mental health crisis needing urgent help.	Assessment, diagnosis, and treatment for adults up to 65 with dementia, families and carers.

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
