Locked Rehabilitation

We work therapeutically with service users to reduce their risks to themselves or others while increasing engagement and independence.

Low Secure Forensic Service Leeds

This service provides inpatient, outpatient and community outreach support to the local Leeds population.

Low Secure Forensic Service York

We provide an inpatient service to adults in York from a range of pathways.

Memory Assessment

This team provides assessment, diagnosis, treatment and support for people with dementia and mild cognitive impairment.

National Inpatient Centre for Psychological Medicine

Delivering bio-psychosocial holistic care for people with complex medically unexplained symptoms and physical / psychological co-morbidities.

Northern Gambling Service

We provide specialist addiction therapy and recovery to people affected by gambling addiction.

Older People's Inpatient Services

For people with acute mental health needs including dementia, provided 24 hours a day in a hospital setting.

Older People's Community Mental Health

This is a dedicated service for those over 65 and living in Leeds.

Pathway Development Service – Yorkshire and Humberside

Serving people diagnosed with severe personality disorder.

Perinatal Mental Health Service

Our specialist service supports women with significant mental health difficulties during pregnancy and the first year following a child's birth.

Personality Disorder Managed Clinical Network (Leeds)

This service works with people with personality disorder, complex needs, and significant risk issues. It is multi agency and multi-disciplinary.

Pharmacy

The pharmacy team work alongside medical, nursing and other clinical staff to ensure medicines are used safely.

Psychiatric Care Intensive Service

The Leeds Psychiatric Care Intensive Service cares for adults whose risks and behaviours cannot be managed on an open acute ward.

Rehab and Recovery Inpatient

These services offer comprehensive assessment and individual care packages in a safe and supportive environment.

Specialised Supported Living Service

This service helps adults with varying degrees of learning and physical disabilities and complex needs to live independently.

Veterans' Mental Health Complex Treatment Service

The Veterans' Mental Health Complex Treatment Service is a specialist community service for armed forces veterans.

Veterans' Mental Health High Intensity Service – North of England

This team provides care and treatment for armed forces veterans in a mental health crisis needing urgent help.

Younger People with Dementia Service

Assessment, diagnosis, and treatment for adults up to 65 with dementia, families and carers.

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
