

Applications are invited for the post of Locum Consultant in Gynaecological Oncology at the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital. This is a 12-month post that will lead to a permanent position after this period. This post was created to support the expansion of the gynaecological oncology services in the Norfolk area. The successful candidate will join a team of 4 sub-specialty trained gynaecological oncologists.

The applicants must be fully registered with the GMC and have completed sub-specialty training in Gynaecological Oncology (or equivalent experience) or must be within 6 months of obtaining the accreditation. The post holder will be expected to contribute to all aspects of care for patients diagnosed with gynaecological cancers, including cytoreductive surgery and hyperthermic intraperitoneal chemotherapy for patients with metastatic ovarian cancer.
